The Turnbow Foundation Scholarship is specifically designed for dedicated, low-income single parents over the age of 21 who reside in Arizona. This scholarship supports students committed to completing the Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Health Information Technology (HIT) or the Medical Coding Programs at Phoenix College within 36 months of starting the program.

Scholarship Coverage

- Full tuition covered if completed within 36 months.
- Program school books costs covered.
- Funds are disbursed **directly to the school** on a semester-by-semester basis.

Academic Requirements

To remain eligible for continued funding each semester:

- Students must **submit grades to the Foundation** at the end of each semester.
- Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Students must **remain enrolled in the** Health Information Management Programs **the entire time**.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a low-income, single parent, 21 years or older.
- Must live in Arizona.
- Must be accepted into the Program(s) at Phoenix College.
- Must be a committed to 9 credit hours per semester minimum

Additional Needs

- Answer short answer questions essay form
- 2 letters of recommendation (professional references only)
- Unofficial transcripts
- Zoom Interview meeting
