The Turnbow Foundation Scholarship is specifically designed for **dedicated, low-income single parents over the age of 21** who **reside in Arizona**. This scholarship supports students committed to completing the **Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Health Information Technology (HIT) or the Medical Coding Programs** at **Phoenix College** within **36 months of starting the program**.

Scholarship Coverage

- **Full tuition** covered if completed within 36 months.
- **Program school books** costs covered.
- Funds are disbursed **directly to the school** on a semester-by-semester basis.

Academic Requirements

To remain eligible for continued funding each semester:

- Students must **submit grades to the Foundation** at the end of each semester.
- Students must **maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher**.
- Students must **remain enrolled in the Health Information Management Programs the entire time**.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a **low-income, single parent, 21 years or older**.
- Must **live in Arizona**.
- Must be **accepted into the Program(s)** at Phoenix College.
- Must be a **committed to 9 credit hours per semester minimum**

- Answer short answer questions **essay form**
- **2 letters of recommendation (professional references only)**
- Unofficial transcripts
- Zoom Interview meeting
