Individuals with COVID-like Symptoms or tested positive for COVID-19: (Regardless of Vaccine Status)

Isolate yourself for a minimum of 5 days and monitor your symptoms. You are able to return to in-person classes/work when **all four** of the following CDC criteria have been met.

- 1. At least 5 days since symptoms first appeared and
- 2. At least 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medication and
- 3. Other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving or have completely resolved (and no new symptoms appear) **and**
- 4. Continue to wear a mask/face covering around others for 5 additional days after isolation is discontinued.

Potential Exposure to a COVID-19 positive individual:

If you are asymptomatic and any of the following scenarios apply to your situation:

 Completed the two dose vaccine series for either Pfizer or Moderna within 6 months of your potential exposure or

• You have recovered from COVID-19 within 3 months of your potential exposure.	
If you are asymptomatic and any of the following scenarios apply to your situation:

	Stay home for 7 days after your last
 Completed the primary series of J&J <u>over 2</u> <u>months ago</u> and are not boosted or 	exposure. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional
Are unvaccinated or	days.**
Have not recovered from COVID-19 within 3 months of your potential exposure.	

** If you develop COVID-19 like symptoms or test positive during your quarantine, regardless of your vaccine status, you must isolate and complete the online form titled as "<u>Report Symptoms or Confirmed Case</u>" immediately. **Please note that you will still need to follow MCCCD COVID-19 protocols (including face coverings and social distancing) after the "quarantine requirements have been fulfilled.**
