



Once you have registered for your dual enrollment classes, you can pay your tuition and fees online or set up a payment plan.

1. First, log in to the **Student Center** at [maricopa.edu/student-center](https://maricopa.edu/student-center) using your MEID@maricopa.edu login (example: BER3455706@maricopa.edu) and your password.
2. Select the **Financial Account** option.
3. On the **Make a Payment** page, select the charges you wish to pay.
4. Next, you will be directed to create a **Nelnet** account.
5. You have the option to pay your tuition in full or select a payment plan. Follow the instructions as needed.
6. If you need assistance with making a payment, contact your college's office of **Student Business Services**.
